COURSE DESCRIPTION

Course name: **Fire Safety in Industry - Fire Wardens/Marshall**

Course Description: A one day session covering the role of the Fire Warden, with specific regard to the hazards present at your site.

Recommended attendance: The staff employed in your premises with a special responsibility for the fire safety acting as Fire Wardens, both Senior and Deputy Wardens.

Aim: To train Fire Wardens in the basics of fire prevention and extinguishing in order that they might reduce the possibility of fire and extinguish a small fire if one occurs. To give the skills required to be able to monitor the general fire safety of their working area on a day to day basis with specific regard to the requirements of the fire certificate or risk assessment, which ever is applicable to your site.

Learning objectives: Having completed the course the delegates will be able to:

- Identify the main causes of fire in the workplace.
- State the action to be taken to prevent fires.
- Monitor fire safety in the workplace.
- Recognise the correct extinguisher to use on different types of fire.
- Use an extinguisher correctly.
- Make an emergency call to the Fire Service.
- Carry out a fire evacuation procedure in accordance with Company Policy.
- Advise other members of staff on the danger of fire and the action required on discovery of a fire.

Subjects Covered:

- Causes of fire
- The physics of fire
- Fire prevention
- The fire certificate
- Methods of extinguisher small fires.
- Identification of extinguishers.
- Use of extinguishers
- Call the Fire Service and evacuating the premises
- Fire drill procedures.

Method: The learning objectives will be achieved by theoretical and practical input supported by OHP transparencies, video playback, delegate's notes and operational equipment.

Assessment: A test will be set to ensure a level of competence has been achieved and a Certificate awarded to those delegates who reach a satisfactory standard.
